

Nook (E-ink readers)

1. The Nook **does not require an app** to be installed on the device.
2. Go to the GADD website from a computer.
3. Download the Adobe Digital Editions 2.0 software, located on the left side of the web page under “Digital Software” to your **home computer or laptop**. Adobe Digital Editions **can’t** be installed on the library public computers. <http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html>
4. After you have installed and opened the software, it is recommended that you select “yes” when the option to authorize your device pops up. If you plan to transfer an eBook from one computer to another or to a device (such as your Nook), you must authorize your Adobe Digital Editions. Both the eBook device and the software must be activated with the same Adobe ID to transfer DRM-protected eBooks to the device.
5. Next, once on the GADD website, you can browse genres for eBooks (Adobe EPUB and Open EPUB), explore the “Digital Help - FAQ” and the “Checkout Assistance,” view the “Guided Tour,” and try out the “My Help” link as well.
6. Click on titles for a description and digital rights information. In the “Format Information” section, check the availability of the eBook and place a hold on the item if it is not currently available.
7. Add titles to your cart to check out. You must sign in with your library card number and PIN. You can check out a maximum of 5 titles for a lending period of 7 or 14 days.
8. Click “Confirm Check Out,” and then “Download.” Select “Open with” and make sure the option “Adobe Digital Editions (default)” is selected. Click “OK.” The download will begin automatically once Adobe Digital Editions opens.
9. If you authorized your Adobe Digital Editions, now connect your Nook to your computer with your USB cable, and activate it as well. If you do not have an Adobe ID, you will need to register for one.
10. To transfer your eBooks to your device, select the “Library View” icon in the upper left corner. Then drag and drop the titles from your library (in the right pane) to your Nook (in the left pane). For a list of supported devices, see <http://overdrive.com/resources/drc>
11. Titles will expire and be automatically “returned” at the end of the lending period. You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from this site. From Adobe Digital Editions, you can return an eBook early.
12. Close Adobe Digital Editions and safely disconnect your Nook from your computer.
13. When using the Nook, the book you just downloaded will **not** appear on your main library shelf. To find your Overdrive titles, you will have to click on “Library” and then “My Documents.”
